## Wayne County Special Service District No. 1

The Wayne County Special Service District No. 1 (the "District") was formed in 1988 for the purpose of constructing, repairing, and maintaining roads, and to provide facilities for hospital, recreation, flood control and other lawful public purposes authorized by law within the boundaries of the District. Most or all of the funds received by the District are from mineral lease royalties generated from production of oil, natural gas and coal on federal lands within the State of Utah. By law 48% of these funds are to be returned to the State to offset direct or in-direct impacts from activities associated with production of these resources on state, county and local communities. According to federal (30 U.S.C. 191) and State (UCA 59-21-1,2) laws these funds are to be used for i) planning; ii) construction and maintenance of public facilities; and iii) provision of public services. According to Congress these funds are to be used to assist local communities in providing traditional local government services and facilities that may be impacted by resource development. Also according to the Utah State Constitution public funds cannot be expended for private purposes.

The District has three Board of Trustee members that are appointed by the Wayne County Commission. These Board members must elect a chairman to conduct the meetings and also a clerk and treasurer. The clerk and the treasurer can be other than Board members. The Board should meet at least quarterly.

The District cannot fund private individuals, private groups, or private non-profit organizations. These individuals or organizations must find funding elsewhere.
